What's in it for the students?

We will be working with teams of Year 9 students (aged 13 – 14) from local Horsham schools. The students will develop their numeracy skills, employability and enterprise skills such as decision making, communication, team working and presentation. They will also learn about how the Stock Market operates and how to take risks!

What's in it for you?

This is a great opportunity to raise awareness of your business, develop students' skills for business, put something back into the local community and have some fun!

The Activity

Students working in teams will be buying and selling on a simulated trading floor. They can invest in 9 companies and the US dollar based on information they get from TV, radio news and a news website integrated into the simulation. Prices are affected not only by the information in the news but also by what teams do, making for a genuinely interactive experience. The trades are recorded using paper shares and banker's drafts. The business volunteers will act as advisers to the teams.
